Dear Resident & Family,

Bellaire at Stone Port is concerned for the ongoing welfare, safety, and health of our residents. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) continues to monitor the outbreak of COVID-19. The people most likely to become severely ill from COVID-19 are older adults and those with underlying medical conditions.

This letter is to alert you that on July 1, 2020 we learned that one of our associates developed COVID-19. Based on information that was provided to the Virginia Department of Health (VDH), the associate was not in contact with our residents during the infectious period. As a result, VDH has advised that no further precautions or testing is recommended at this time. We are actively monitoring our residents for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and are working with our local and state health departments.

All our team members continue to follow the CDC's recommendations to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. These include strict handwashing procedures, wearing facemasks, and in many circumstances, gowns, and gloves when interacting with residents who are sick.

To minimize the risk of our residents becoming sick with COVID-19, we are going to continue to limit visits to Bellaire at Stone Port. We will continue to allow outside patio visits that will need to be scheduled with the concierge. We understand that connecting with family members is important. Other ways to connect include telephone, email, text, or through Skype or Facebook.
