Fun and Functional Nutcrackers

Standing at attention with their tall hats and toothy grins, nutcrackers are a festive seasonal sight, but do you know the story behind the ornamental soldiers?

Various tools for cracking open nuts, from simple levers to screw designs, have been around for centuries and were usually made of metal. In the 1700s, woodworkers in Germany began carving nutcrackers in the shapes of soldiers and kings. Symbols of good luck and protection, the dolls were traditionally given as gifts. Pressing a handle on the back of the figurine enabled its mouth to move up and down to crack open a nut.

The march of nutcrackers into the U.S. was spurred by two factors. During World War II, many American soldiers stationed in Germany bought nutcrackers as souvenirs for their loved ones. Around the same time, Peter Tchaikovsky's ballet "The Nutcracker" debuted in the U.S. and became a hit, making the character a beloved icon.

While traditional soldiers remain a popular design, whimsical figures of all kinds can now be found.
